

Dear Pennsylvania U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary Member:

We are pleased to announce this exclusive offer to members of the U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary with cars registered in Pennsylvania who are eligible for a new Specialty License Plate. The Fifth Northern District, Division 4, Flotilla 9 (053-04-09) administers the program. You can order one or more of these distinctive plates.

Benefits of owning a unique license plate ?

- Showcase a beautiful plate featuring a full color auxiliary logo and the words, "U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary" across the bottom on your personal vehicle(s).
- You help raise awareness of the Auxiliary.
- It helps give the Auxiliary visibility with recruiting new members.
- ***Most of all you can show your pride as a member of the Auxiliary !***



Some Program Guidelines:

- You cannot request a number for the plates, they will be issued upon receiving your applications.
 - You cannot request to have any letters or personalized message on your plates.
 - Your old license plate should be mailed to PennDOT after you receive your new specialty plate. The address is on the bottom of the application (FORM MV-904SP (5-25))
 - You must be an *active* member of the U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary to obtain one of these plates and your vehicle must be registered in Pennsylvania.
 - The \$85 is a one-time fee. You will own that plate and number for the rest of your life if you wish to. You must however remain an active member of the Auxiliary.
 - These plates are only available through the Auxiliary and cannot be purchased through any Tag/Title location.
 - “The applicant will receive a new plate, a new registration sticker that will match the date of their old sticker and a new registration card for the new plate/sticker. The fee for the specialty plate does not include registration time. We “transfer” the registration time from their old plate to their new plate. When their registration is about to expire, they will receive a renewal application for the new plate, just like they did for the old plate. They must have current/valid registration on their old plate when we go to process their application, so I recommend that any that are about to expire, renew now.” (Direct Answer from PennDOT).
 - License plate numbers are assigned in the order when completed applications and checks are received and forwarded to the Pennsylvania Registry of Motor Vehicles.

- Please fill out Sections A and E on the application FORM MV-904SP (5-25) attached to this program document. You can use the fillable form FORM MV-904SP (5-25)
- Please read the yellow highlighted sections on page 2 of FORM MV-904SP (5-25) under “GENERAL INFORMATION REGARDING A SPECIAL ORGANIZATION REGISTRATION PLATE.”
- Send the application and one check in the amount of \$85.00 made payable to “US Coast Guard Auxiliary Flotilla 4-9” to the program coordinator below;
